Hospitality Rider v.11
September 2023

1. ACCOMMODATION:

Please provide one of two options:

A. 17 single rooms (king-size beds if possible, please)

B. 9 double doubles + 1 king

Important requirements:

- Hotel must be located no more than 15 minutes drive from the venue.
- Marriott Fairfield Inn, Springhill Suites or Hilton Fairfield Inn level or higher.
- Breakfast to be included or paid.
- **Early check-in (12 PM) and/or late check-out (2-4 PM) if needed – to be confirmed with tour manager.**

2. PARKING:

Five (5) parking places next to the venue/hotel free of charge.

We have 5 vehicles:

- 3 x SUV
- 1 x Ram (full size pickup truck)
- 1 x 15 passenger van

3. PROMOTER REPRESENTATIVE:

Promoter provides a representative able to make decisions on promoter's behalf. If radios are used by promoter's crew, the promoter representative should also have one.

4. SOUNDCHECK:

Band needs 4 hours to soundcheck. At crew's arrival all backline and stage must be properly installed and connected according to the input-list.

5. DRESSING ROOMS:

We need 3 lockable dressing rooms for 17 people, with a proper ventilation. Keys must be provided to tour manager upon bands arrival.

Wi-fi access, full length mirrors, hangers, ironing board w/ iron, steamer, chairs, tables, minimum, 4 or more electrical outlets/power strips in each room, trash bins.

In production office please provide:

- 28 x AA batteries (Duracell only)
- 1 x black gaffer tape
- 12 x dark towels
- 8 x sharpies (5 black, 3 silver).

We will need access to a printer to print set-lists.

6. CATERING AND MEAL:

Catering to be provided by the promoter prior to crew arrival, see details below.

6.1. TECH CREW ARRIVAL:

Drinks:

- 12 x bottles of lager beer Yuengling + 12 bottles of wheat beer Blue Moon
- 4 x bottles of white wine (Pinot or Riesling)
- 1 x bottles of red wine (semi dry/dry California or Cabernet)

- 1 carton x «Oatsome» Organic Oat Milk (or similar)
- 1 carton x Organic Almond Milk
- 1 x bottle of Organic Kefir
- 3 x bottles of protein shakes (mixed flavour)

Deli selections and vegetables (**sliced and served on trays, please**):

- 1 pound x assorted organic cheese (Cheddar, Gauda)
- 2 packs x Mozzarella + 2 x Brie Cheese
- 0.5 pounds x organic ham («Boar's Head»)
- 0.5 pounds x organic turkey («Boar's Head» – roasted maple glazed)
- 2 medium containers x organic Tuna salad
- 3 pounds x organic sliced salmon (smoked salmon)
- Lettuce, Celery Sticks, Green Olives (pitted)
- **5 x big tomatoes + 2 packs of tomatoes cherry**
- 1 x onion
- 5 x medium organic cucumbers (or 2 big ones)
- 7 x avocados (soft ones please)
- Organic sourdough bread, organic multi-grain bread and multi-grain crackers

Bowls of fresh fruits particularly:

- **2 x big whole watermelons (sliced please)**
- 1 x pineapple (sliced please)
- Bananas, tangerines, oranges, grapes, blueberries
- Fresh limes, lemons (sliced please)

Misc:

- 2 x options of mixed cereals **without sugar**
- Assorted cookies (homemade style, oatmeal)
- Assorted fresh sauces: **organic Ranch Dressing, mayo and salad dressing (olive oil, balsamic vinegar)**
- **Squeezable honey, ginger**
- Assorted organic tea (black, green, mint and chamomile) and organic fresh brewed hot coffee (good quality organic beans please)
- Unlimited ice, dressing room ice should be replenished every four hours.
- **Brown sugar**, sugar, sugar-substitute packets

Other:

- Cutting board and knife
- 24 x large plastic cups
- 24 x paper cups
- 24 x bowls for soups (suitable for microwave)
- 24 x small plastic cups
- Package of napkins
- 1 x big packet of wet wipes (Oil Of Olay etc)

6.2. TALENT'S ARRIVAL:

Hot soups for 20 ppl, listed in priority: chicken noodle / vegetable soup / broccoli cheddar / chowder / chili / etc @ Whole Foods / Sprouts / Bristol Farms / Natural Patch): 8 x 24 oz bowls OR 15 x 12 oz bowls.

6.3. POST-SHOW MEAL (primary meal):

We will give instructions to the runner to purchase items for dinner – please suggest restaurant options and menu before the show. **No fast or fried food or pizza.** The meal must include chicken, steak and grilled fish options.

7. STAGE/SHOW:

NO opening acts. No other bands performing on the stage at the day of THE L&F show.

Two (2) stagehands needed at load-in and load-out from tech crew arriving till the band leaves the venue.

Local tech crew must be present during the show.

Band needs 20 min. intermission half way through the show.

Only band's production manager can give a cue to house lights off, announcements and beginning of the gig.

Once show has started, timing cannot be changed

8. Festivals or outdoor venues:

Promoter takes full responsibility for any gear damage because of weather conditions.

9. SECURITY:

Please provide security suitable for an event of this nature. We will require adequate security personnel to keep the backstage & stage areas secure & to insure the safety of the audience. Crowd safety barriers should be provided. Front of house mixer position will require one steward from doors until the auditorium is clear.

Promoter takes full responsibility for all artist's items such as gear and personal belongings.

10. TICKETS & PASSES:

Promoter provides 30 complimentary tickets.

Band will be using own laminates and stickers for Photo, AAA, VIP.

- AAA Pass - All Access, Backstage & Green Room – no dressing rooms.
- Photo Pass - House photography, no stage or backstage access.
- VIP Pass - Meet & Greet Access.

22. MERCHANDISE:

Promoter provides 2–3 tables or similar space, and a person to assist with selling merchandise.

23. PRESS:

Photographers allowed to shoot first 3 songs without flash. No stage access.

2 band photographers are allowed to shoot for the whole show from any location.

Any interviews must be arranged and approved in advance.

Videographers must be approved prior to show. Videotaping is limited to 1 minute segment/per song unless approved in advance. Whole-concert videos are prohibited.

GENERAL INFO & SOUNDCHECK

We need you to provide PA system, FOH console, subsnakes, cables, DIs, stands and all the backline mentioned in this document.

We are carrying with us the monitor console (rackmount mixer to be exact, A&H CDM32) and set of IEMs. We got our own FOH and MON engineers and no LD.

We'll need 4 hours for the full soundcheck, assuming that everything is prepared to the moment of our arrival, (i.e. stage risers are placed according the stage plan, all the requested instruments are on their place, DI-boxes and mics are on their positions on the stage and all the cables is ready to be immediately patched into our I/O device according to the Input List), every piece of the gear is working as expected and soundcheck is not interrupted by any circumstances.

We need stage technician to be around our monitor engineer and sound engineer to be around our FOH engineer at least first 2 hours during the soundcheck and during the whole show.

PA SYSTEM & FOH CONSOLE

We need Allen&Heath dLive S7000/S5000/C3500 control surface and two (2) Ethernet cat 5e or higher cables running from the FOH mixer position to the stage. We can bring the A&H console ourselves for \$500 buy-out. We still will need two Ethernet cables in that case.

The table for the FOH console should be placed on the same level with the most of the viewers. The most desirable distance from the scene is from 1.3x to 1.5x of the distance between the main speaker stacks, around the center line between the speakers). The location must provide a good overview of the scene and must be in the line of sight of the main PA system. The console placement under a balcony, stair, etc is unacceptable.

We are expecting full coverage, every and each seat of the first rows with frontfills/infills/centerfills. Frontfills should not be blocked with potentially standing crowd, otherwise, please use infills.

Preferred PA systems are L-Acoustics, Meyer Sound, d&b audiotechnik, Martin Audio.

MONITORS

We don't need any monitor mixer or console. No split needed. We got the whole monitor system covered.

BACKLINE

All the connection types, DIs, microphones and necessary microphone stands listed in Microphone/Input List on pg.4. Please refer to Stage Plan on pg.5 to see where each item must be placed on the stage.

DRUMS

Yamaha or DW drum kit.

- (1) Drum Riser 8'x8' (approx. 2.5m x 2.5m)
- (1) Kick Drum 20"-22"
- (1) Snare Drum 14"
- (1) Rack Tom 1 10"
- (1) Rack Tom 2 12"
- (1) Floor Tom 16"
Zildjian cymbals only. Dark series are preferred.
- (1) Hi-Hat 14"

- (1) Splash 10"
- (1) Ride 20"
- (1) Double Kick Drum Pedal

All the drum stands, mounts, pedals should work as good as new. All the drumheads/skins should be in new condition.

Not Motif ES or Classic. Not "8". 61 or 76 keys only.


