



Band Rider

ON STAGE:

- Absolutely NO FOG / Haze/ Smoke machines [INCLUDING WATER BASED MODELS] are to be used immediately before or during the band's performance. Our vocalist is asthmatic and suffers allergic reactions to the substances used in these devices which adversely affect her voice. Thank you for adhering to this request.
- Our performances have a video accompaniment that syncs to our music [whenever video screens are available]. This is triggered by our drummer from a laptop. We request an HDMI connection for this. Or when video screens are not available, we request the option to either hang our banner or project our logo behind the band whenever possible.

BACK STAGE:

Clean & secure dressing room or greenroom area to include the following [whenever possible]:

- Lights &, electrical outlet
- table & chairs
- Full-length mirror
- Wardrobe rack, or some other means to hang costumes
- A bathroom with toilet & sink in close proximity to the stage.
- 6 clean cloth towels [paper towels are acceptable if cloth is not available]
- Tissues
- Sanitizing wipes and/or hand sanitizer [if available]
- Bottled water [15-20 bottles minimum per show] on ice, and provided in green room or side of stage.
- Hospitality [if available]: light snacks [i.e.: cheese, crackers, chips, vegetable plate, juice/sodas/water, etc.

FOOD/BEVERAGE:

- Meals for 5 adults to include vegetarian options are appreciated.
- Beverages: Sodas [including caffeine-free selections], bottled water, Gatorade, & coffee w/creamers & sugar etc., [if available].
- The option to eat before or after the show [depending on each performer's preference] is kindly requested. If meals are only provided BEFORE the band's performance, we kindly request to eat at least 2 hours before the performance start time, to allow time for digestion and time for band members to change into costumes. LODGING:

- When lodging is provided, we require 4 non-smoking rooms with king or queen beds, fridge & microwave [whenever possible], and we kindly request that the rooms be either on the 1st floor or close to an elevator for the purpose of more easily moving and storing gear [whenever backline is not provided]. And we kindly request that the rooms for our band members be assigned in close proximity to each other for ease in providing costumes to our members.
